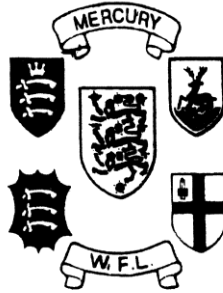

New Club Application

Dear Secretary,

We acknowledge receipt of your application applying to become members of the Constitution of the Mercury Waltham Football League and as such, attach an Application form. When completed will you please return, along with a detailed letter outlining why you want to join our League and any additional information about your Club and in support of your application to me at the address below.

You will then be informed, in March 2010, giving adequate notice, of a date, time and venue so that a panel of the Officers may interview representatives of your club with regard to assessing your application.

Running a football team is now an expensive pastime and initial costs for pitches, County & League affiliations plus a £50 bond (refundable after your first satisfactory season) will be in the region of £400 - £500. This amount is payable at the start of the season with the second half of pitch fees (an additional £300-£350 due in November).

You should have two different coloured kits, match footballs, goal nets, corner flags/posts, at least 18-20 signed players and a Club Bank Account (with adequate funds). Evidence of this should be brought to your interview with League Officers.

The League is committed to giving as many people as possible the opportunity to play football whilst observing the Football Association guidelines as well as maintaining its' own high standards.

We look forward to the return of your application, and if the club is accepted, a long and successful period with the League.
